The palate is powerful yet with a creamy consistency. With a trace of water the peat reek is gentled, allowing the more complex flavours of citrus fruits and spices to come through. A slight tang comes from the European Oak balancing the creamier American White Oak. The finish is mouth filling and extremely long but balanced by the sweet smooth caramel taste.
